Sign up for Apple Arcade for unlimited access to a collection of curated games on your iPhone, iPad, iPod touch, Mac, and Apple TV. After you sign up for Apple Arcade, you can download any Apple Arcade game at no additional cost: On your iPhone, iPad, or iPod touch: Open the App Store and go to the Arcade tab at the bottom of the screen. On your Apple TV: Open the Arcade app, or open the App Store, and go to the Arcade tab at the top of the screen. On your Mac: Open the App Store and go to the Arcade tab in the sidebar.
